

## Official Terms & Conditions: Winglocker South West 20km Challenge

**1. The Promoter** The promoter is Winglocker ("The Promoter"). This promotion is in no way sponsored, endorsed, administered by, or associated with Instagram or Meta.

### 2. Eligibility

- This challenge is open to all unpowered paraglider pilots aged 18 years or over.
- Flights must be conducted on unpowered paragliders only. Paramotors, hang gliders, sailplanes, speed wings, and mini-wings are strictly excluded.
- Employees of Winglocker or their family members are not eligible to enter.

**3. The Challenge Structure & Timeline** The challenge is split into two phases: The Qualifiers and The September Sprint.

- **The Qualifiers:** Pilots must log at least one successful 20km+ flight in each of the following five months: April, May, June, July, and August. Only pilots who successfully log a flight in all five months advance to the final.
- **The September Sprint (The Finale):** The race begins on September 1st. The Grand Prize goes to the *first* qualified pilot to log a successful 20km+ flight in September.

### 4. Flight & Distance Requirements

- **Single Flight Rule:** The 20km minimum distance must be achieved in a single, continuous flight. Cumulative distances from multiple short flights on the same day will not count.
- **Distance Calculation:** Flight distance will be calculated based on standard "**Optimized Free Distance**" (**Start + up to 3 Turnpoints + Finish**), exactly as calculated by default on platforms like XContest or Leonardo. League multipliers (e.g., FAI triangle bonuses) will not be applied.
- **Location Requirements:** To qualify, the entirety of the 20km flight track must occur within the designated South West boundary. (*Note: Insert link to map or list of valid counties here*).

### 5. How to Enter & Log Flights

- **Initial Entry (Before March 31st):** Pilots must follow @winglocker on Instagram and share the official challenge announcement post to their Instagram Story.
- **Logging a Flight:** Every claimed flight must be recorded via GPS and logged publicly on a recognized flight tracking platform (e.g., XContest, Leonardo, Strava).
- **Social Media Tagging:** Upon completing a qualifying flight, the pilot must post a photo (a landing selfie or safe action-cam shot) to Instagram, tag @winglocker, and include the exact caption: "*That was for WingLocker!*"

### 6. Prizes & Voucher Terms

- **Grand Prize:** A £500 Winglocker voucher awarded to the first qualified pilot to log a 20km flight in September.
- **Finisher Prize:** A free Winglocker neck tube awarded to any pilot who completes the full 6-month challenge (Qualifiers + a September 20km flight), but who is not the first to do so.
- **Bonus Prizes:** Winglocker merchandise awarded at the end of the season for *Best Selfie*, *Most Attempts logged*, and *Shortest Combined Airtime* (calculated across the pilot's 5 qualifying flights).
- **Strict Voucher Rules:** The £500 voucher is strictly valid **only against the purchase of a brand-new paraglider wing at standard Recommended Retail Price (RRP)** directly from Winglocker. It cannot be used for discounted wings, second-hand gear, harnesses, or accessories. Vouchers cannot be combined and have no cash value.

## 7. Verification & Safety

- Winglocker reserves the right to review public GPS tracks to ensure validity, distance calculation, and location compliance.
- Flights that violate UK airspace or local site rules will be immediately disqualified. The Promoter's decision on flight validity is final.
- Pilots are entirely responsible for their own safety and decision-making.

**8. Media & Consent** By participating and tagging @winglocker, entrants grant Winglocker permission to reshare their images, Stories, and flight statistics on Winglocker's social channels and website for promotional purposes.
